The Air Force announced new policies on dress and appearance with regard to tattoos Jan. 9. Authorized tattoos on the chest, back, arms and legs will no longer be restricted by the "25 percent" rule. Hand tattoos will be limited to one single-band ring tattoo, on one finger, on one hand.
